- More collaboration between various healthcare authorities

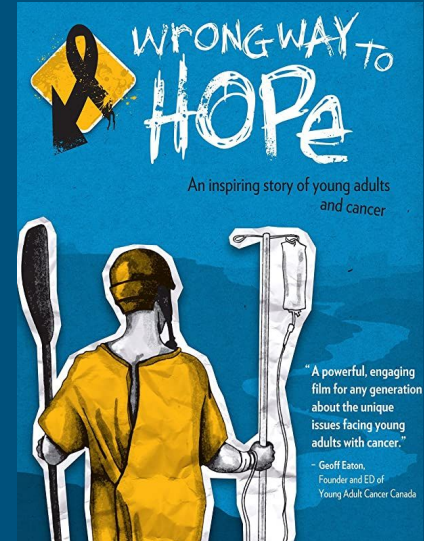


Film - Wrong Way to Hope

An inspiring film about a group of young adults who embark on a kayaking expedition in Oregon as a context for sharing their personal journeys as survivors of cancer.

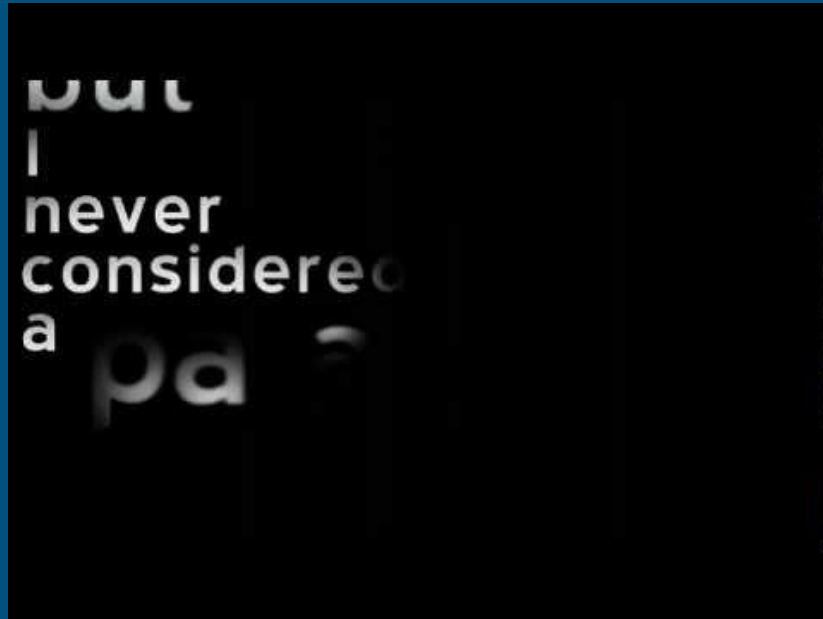
