



PULPIT project (in a nutshell)

General Objective: To foster the active and properly prepared Public and Patient involvement (PPI) in the education of undergraduate healthcare students, in the classroom, promoting an interprofessional (IPE) person-centred care discussion about the physical, mental and social impact of illness.

Assessment of Usability and acceptability: improvements

The students develop a collaborative health management plan and present it to all group for discussion

Each PEP receives 3 students at a place of his/her choice to discuss the "Physical, mental and social implications of chronic illness"

The PULPIT programme is presented by the Professors/Facilitators to all group, setting up the "rules of function" for the educational activity.

In each country, 8-12 students (dif. professions), 4 Patient Education Partners (PeP) and 2 professors volunteer for the PULPIT programme and start with the **MOOC** (including PCC educational materials)
